Diamonds: The Perfect Gift



hodium is a rare, naturally occurring member of the platinum group of metals. It is extremely tough and able to resist corrosion and scratches. Normally seen in silver-white, it has commonly been used for years as a plating to give a lustrous finish to white gold.

Today, jewelry designers across the world seem to be exploring their dark sides with a newer, inkier shade of black rhodium designs. This edgy metal adds drama and an almost rock-star-chic look to classic designs. The jet-black, highly polished or matte finish creates stunning effects when used underneath or alongside gemstones, making lighter colored gems pop, while enhancing the edginess of dark gems.

How To Care For Your Diamonds

iamond is the hardest natural substance on Earth. It can cut any kind of rock or metal and yet the oil deposited from the human finger can cause dirt to collect and cause this nearly indestructible gemstone to quickly lose its brilliance and fire.

It is a good practice to clean your diamonds regularly by soaking them in water with a gentle dish soap, once or twice a week. After removing them from the solution, use a soft, clean toothbrush to remove any remaining dirt. Be sure to brush gently to avoid any potential damage and weakening of prongs. Rinse your diamond jewelry with warm water

and dry with a soft, lint-free cloth. If you are working over a sink, be sure to close the drain!

Don't take chances! To maintain your diamonds' brilliance and avoid the risk of a precious diamond falling out, visit us every three months to have your diamond jewelry professionally cleaned and your settings checked for wear.



What Is A See-Through Test?

The test is used to tell if a diamond is genuine or an imitation. The diamond is placed faced down on a newspaper or magazine. If lettering can be seen through the stone as if it were seen through glass it is probably an imitation.

Who Was Marcel Tolkowsky?

In 1919 Marcel Tolkowsky's revolutionary observations established the precise proportions of a diamond's cut needed to maximize its brilliance and dispersion of light. He invented the Ideal Cut and changed the way we look at diamonds forever.

What Is A Demi-Parure?

A demi-parure is a small set of two or three matching pieces of jewelry usually consisting of a necklace, pin, bracelet, or earrings. The pieces can be combined in various ways. A parure is a set of four different matching pieces.
